



DEVICE SIZE MATTERS

The PACC Guidelines recommend that all first responders should be trained to identify patients with implantable systems. Implantable systems can include pacemakers, spinal cord stimulation devices, and implantable pumps. Each device has a different size and dimension, may be circular or other shapes.

This visual guide illustrates the size and shape of different devices and can be used as a resource for first responders and for patients/caregivers in case of emergency.
