"Traditional statistical methods have their value, but so do innovative models for approaching problems from different angles. After earning her PhD, Dr. Reiter's introduction to continuing education came in the form of an editor position at CME, LLC, then later as a writer of Category 1 articles, and finally Director of Biostatistics and Research. In addition to working in the CME industry, Dr. Reiter has held research, statistics, and writing positions at UC Irvine's Institute for Brain Aging and Dementia, the Alzheimer's Disease Research Center at UC San Diego, and in the biotech/pharma industry. With a goal of making statistics more "friendly," Dr. Reiter also developed biostatistics courses for UC San Diego's extension program.

While Director of Biostatistics and Research at CME LLC, Dr. Reiter noticed a lack of statistical rigor in the industry, and made it her mission to educate providers. She presented at the ACEhp annual meeting, where she highlighted not only the importance of statistical analysis in demonstrating activity success, but in utilizing the appropriate statistical methods given the types of data collected. She was then invited to serve on a panel as statistical expert at the IACE (formerly PACME) Spring Summit. In continuation of her goal of providing innovative and valuable approaches to outcomes, Dr. Reiter has already begun implementing an offering unique to CMEO. PredictCME is based on CHAID (chi-square automatic interaction detection), a predictive modeling technique often used in data mining. "By using PredictCME, we are able to better understand influences of practice behaviors, which can help us tailor educational activities to maximize impact."

Dr. Reiter also hopes to continue building on quality improvement initiatives and incorporating patient data; focus on improving confidence, which has been shown to influence behavior; incorporate adult learning principles and personalized education; and utilize the latest technology to optimize learning.

"Overall," said Reiter, "my goal is to help CME Outfitters stay at the forefront as a best-in-class, forward-thinking CME provider and medical education company with a commitment to quality, integrity and optimal patient outcomes."
