Upcoming Live Webcast from CME Outfitters to Cover Focal Seizures in ICU Setting

Early treatment of seizures has been linked to better outcomes in patients and increased survival rates, making it imperative that the clinicians who treat ICU patients possess the knowledge and confidence to quickly identify and optimally manage seizures to ensure optimal outcomes for their patients. Participants of this webcast should be able to describe potential causes of focal seizures in ICU patients and factors that complicate seizure management, select appropriate treatments, and develop an appropriate treatment plan for continued long-term treatment at time of patient discharge.
