*Poorly or inadequately controlled signs and symptoms of AD. **Before stepping up therapy, the patient should be assessed for nonadherence, potential comorbidities, and other factors that might negatively affect response to therapy. ¹Indicated for patients at least 2 years old with mild to moderate AD. 3Indicated for patients at least 18 years old with moderate to severe AD.
